## Big Picture

- » State job growth rose 2.3% in April 2014 from a year ago; national job growth rose 1.7%
- » State unemployment averaged 7.3% in April 2014; the national average was 6.3%
- » Personal income rose 0.7% to \$1.8 trillion in Q4 2013 from a year ago.
- » Tax revenue increased 7.9% in Q4 2013 from a year ago.
- » Exports rose 4.8% to \$28.9 billion in the first two months of 2014 from a year ago.

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
